

Spelling list: Words ending in *or*

Many words use the letters *or* to spell the weak vowel ending.

The *or* ending is often found after the letters *ct* , *it* , *at* , *ss* , and *rr* .

actor	The actor forgot his lines.
collector	He was an avid collector of stamps.
doctor	She asked the doctor to examine her ears.
visitor	As a visitor , I must report to the reception desk.
editor	My editor is currently reading my new book.
alligator	He saw an alligator in the wild.
calculator	Did you use a calculator for that equation?
predecessor	He was concerned that he would be overshadowed by his predecessor .
professor	The professor gave a lecture on ancient history.
horror	The horror film made me squirm.
mirror	We have a large mirror in our hall.
error	He couldn't believe the spelling error he had made.
anchor	The ship dropped anchor in the bay.
donor	Tony has been a blood donor for many years.
survivor	One survivor was found in the collapsed building.
