Spelling list: ea words

In words like reach, dream, and wheat, the long /e/ sound is spelt using the letters ea.

Notice how the *long vowel sound* in each example in this list falls in the middle of the word. Exceptions to this rule include: *plea*, *flea*, and *sea*.

reach The higher shelf is out of my **reach**.

deal His manner conveyed a great **deal** of arrogance.

dream What did you **dream** about last night?

fear Many people have a **fear** of snakes.

wheat Bread is made from wheat.

feast We shared a splendid **feast** .

breathe He needs a ventilator to help him **breathe**.

leave Switch off the lights when you **leave** the room.

squeak The mouse began to **squeak**.

appear You **appear** to be upset.

beaver We saw a **beaver** by the stream today.

beneath The tourists stood **beneath** the arch.

creature A crocodile is a very dangerous **creature**.

decrease There was a **decrease** in population.

repeat Using a stencil allows a painter to **repeat** a pattern.
