The letter *y* is used to spell the long /i/ sound at the end of the words in this list.

Say the words aloud as you learn them. Can you hear the *long vowel sound* at the end of each word?

cry	The baby started to cry when she was hungry.
dry	I dry my hair with a towel.
fry	Shall we fry an egg for breakfast?
fly	I love to fly my kite.
sly	The sly fox burrowed under the fence.
