The letter y is used to spell the long /i/ sound in these words.

Say the words aloud as you learn them. Can you hear the *long vowel sound* ?

type	A popular <b>type</b> of nut is the cashew nut.
cycle	I prefer to <b>cycle</b> to work rather than going by bus.
