

Spelling list: words used in year 7 part 1

Words that are commonly used within your lessons.

Design	The 'back wall' of the stage; often a large curtain, sometimes with a picture or design .
tone	The black and white painting had a large range of different tones.
Tonal	The painting could be considered tonal , due to its good use of shade.
shade	Jodie's dress was a vibrant shade of turquoise.
Shading	The young boy had bought some new pencils which helped him with his shading .
Line	A straight line from the centre of a circle.
Linear	The picture was made up of lots of lines and could be described as linear .
Observe	It is very important to observe what is going on in and outside of the frame.
Observational	The drawings of the flowers could be described as observational .
Research	Research in Art influences your own work.
History	Learning about the past is defined as history .
Historical	The news published a chronicle of the historical event.
Annotation	The research had clear annotation , explaining what the viewer felt about the work.
Perspective	Perspective , the art of representing three-dimensional objects on a two-dimensional surface.
Composition	This is the way a scene or image has been composed- the composition can be symmetrical.
Proportion	The portrait was not in proportion .

Crosshatching	The drawing was made up of criss cross lines instead of shading called crosshatch.
Blending	The girl used the watercolours correctly by blending the colours.
Scale	An enlargement is where an object has been made larger (or smaller) by applying a scale factor.
