Friction The force between two moving surfaces or objects is called **friction**.

Newton was a scientist who gives his name to Newton-metre and some Newton

Force The **force** needed to be overcome to allow the object to move.

Resistance With strength - amount of force a muscle can exert against **resistance**.

Weight A pulley can be used to lift a heavy **weight**.

Reaction Reaction force opposes gravity.

In physics, a force is any **interaction** that, when unopposed, will change the Interaction

motion of an object.

Tension High **tension**.

Balanced A state in which opposing forces are **balanced**.

Unbalanced When one force is larger than the other, the forces are **unbalanced**.

Constant The trophy is a **constant** reminder of his success.

Stationary Our train was **stationary** for over an hour.

Resultant The overall force is the **resultant** force.

Equilibrium is reached when the resultant forces balance out to zero, so the

motion doesn't change (e.g. a parked car).
