

## Spelling list: y in the middle (British)

The letter *y* in the middle of a word often represents the long vowel sound /i/, as seen in words like *rhyme* , *style* , and *cycle* . It is commonly used in words that have a Greek or Latin origin.

Other examples of *y* to spell the long /i/ sound include *psychology* , *dynamic* , and *hydrogen* .

rhyme	These words all rhyme: time, crime, chime.
style	The victorious team celebrated in <b>style</b> .
type	A fern is a <b>type</b> of plant.
cycle	We all <b>cycle</b> to work.
dynamic	Beth has a very <b>dynamic</b> personality.
hyena	The <b>hyena</b> feeds on dead animals.
hyphen	Do you know how to use a <b>hyphen</b> correctly?
hydrogen	<b>Hydrogen</b> is a highly inflammable gas.
pylon	The wire was strung to a <b>pylon</b> .
python	A <b>python</b> kills its prey by crushing it.
typhoon	Two ships were sunk in the <b>typhoon</b> .
tyrant	The powerful leader was a <b>tyrant</b> .
paralyse	In the worst of cases, the poison can <b>paralyse</b> your body.
hygiene	We were taught all about the importance of <b>hygiene</b> when cooking.
psychology	My brother is studying <b>psychology</b> at college.
psychiatry	<b>Psychiatry</b> is the study and treatment of mental illness.
analyse	Can you <b>analyse</b> these results for me?
