area	An area is a particular geographical region of indefinite boundary.
cave	A cave is a geological formation consisting of an underground enclosure with access from the surface of the ground or from the sea.
desert	A desert is arid land with little or no vegetation.
field	A field is a piece of enclosed land cleared of trees.
forest	A forest is a land that is covered with trees and shrubs.
gulf	A gulf is a deep wide chasm.
hill	A hill is a local and well-defined elevation of the land.
jungle	A jungle is an impenetrable equatorial forest.
lake	A lake is a body of (usually fresh) water surrounded by land.
mountain	A mountain is a land mass that projects well above its surroundings.
ocean	An ocean is a large body of water that constitutes a principal part of the hydrosphere.
region	A region is a large indefinite location on the surface of the Earth.
river	A river is a large natural stream of water.
sea	A sea is a division of an ocean or a large body of salt water partially enclosed by land.
stream	A stream is a natural body of running water flowing on or under the earth.
valley	A valley a long depression in the surface of the land that usually contains a river.
