Hemingway's spare prose captures the brutality of war, the complexities of love, and the themes of loss, disillusionment, and the search for meaning in a chaotic world.

Henry	Lieutenant Frederic <b>Henry</b> , an American ambulance driver, finds love and confronts the brutality of war.
Barkley	Catherine <b>Barkley</b> is a nurse who becomes Henry's love interest and offers him solace and support.
Rinaldi	<b>Rinaldi</b> , Henry's friend and a surgeon in the Italian army, displays a charming and hedonistic personality.
Greff	Count <b>Greff</b> is an older Italian noblemen who provides wisdom and a cynical perspective on war.
Ferguson	Helen <b>Ferguson</b> Barkley's friend and fellow nurse at the American hospital.
Van Campen	Miss <b>Van Campen</b> is the superintendent of nurses at the American hospital in Milan.
Gage	Miss <b>Gage</b> is a nurse who helps Henry recover and becomes his friend.
Valentini	Dr. <b>Valentini</b> is an Italian surgeon who operates on Henry.
Moretti	Ettore <b>Moretti</b> , an Italian soldier from San Francisco, fights alongside Henry and experiences the horrors of war.
Gino	<b>Gino</b> is Henry's Italian friend who is extremely patriotic.
Emilio	<b>Emilio</b> is a bartender in Stresa who becomes a good friend to Henry.
Simmons	Ralph <b>Simmons</b> and Edgar Saunders are opera singers.
Saunders	Ralph Simmons and Edgar <b>Saunders</b> are opera singers.
Bonello	<b>Bonello</b> is a ruthless ambulance driver under Henry's command.
