

## Spelling list: *ign* words

*Ign* words feature a silent *g* and use *i* to spell the long /i/ sound.

For example, in *sign* , the *g* is not pronounced, but the *i* still makes a long sound. Similarly, in *design* , the *g* is silent, but the *i* remains long.

Click on the *speaker icon* to hear the pronunciation of each word and have a go at saying each one.

sign	The <b>sign</b> showed which way to go.
design	We are looking for someone to <b>design</b> our logo.
resign	His decision to <b>resign</b> from the position was regrettable.
consign	The zoo decided to <b>consign</b> the lion to the vet.
align	I hope the stars will <b>align</b> for us.
assign	We need to <b>assign</b> roles to each employee.
ensign	An <b>ensign</b> is a flag.
