

Spelling list: o-e words - set 2

A split digraph is a spelling pattern where two letters, typically a vowel and an e , work together to create a single sound in a word, even though they are separated by another letter. In this list of longer words, the split digraph o-e is used to spell the long /o/ sound. By adding the e , you make the o say its name.

Test yourself on these longer o-e words using our *Learn the Words* activities.

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| hormone | Insulin is hormone produced in the pancreas. |
| parole | The prisoner was granted parole . |
| compose | The boy band want to compose a new hit song. |
| suppose | I suppose we'd better get a move on. |
| provoke | He told his son not to provoke him. |
| ozone | Aerosol cans cause harm to the ozone layer. |
| remote | We visited a remote island. |
| microbe | A microbe is a tiny life form that can cause illness. |
| corrode | The metal began to corrode . |
| envelope | This envelope needs a stamp. |
| microscope | You will see this more clearly under the microscope . |
| telescope | Use a telescope to see in the distance. |
| telephone | Have you got the store's telephone number? |
