In these words the long /o/ sound is spelled with just the letter o .

poll	We took a <b>poll</b> of people's views.
toll	You must pay a <b>toll</b> to cross this bridge.
troll	A <b>troll</b> lived under the bridge.
scroll	<b>Scroll</b> down the page to find more tips.
stroll	They went for a <b>stroll</b> by the river.
wold	High ground can be called a <b>wold</b> .
