

Spelling list: u-e words - set 2

This list focuses on longer words that spell the long /u/ sound with the letters *u-e* . These terms are more advanced and cover various contexts, from actions to objects. For example, *capsule* refers to a small container, often used for medication, while *perfume* is a fragrant liquid. Words like *resume* and *consume* describe actions, such as starting again or using up resources. Other words, like *attitude* and *institute* , relate to behaviours or establishments.

These longer words are great for expanding vocabulary and improving spelling skills.
