

## Spelling list: ew words

Another way of spelling the long /u/ sound at the end of a word is using the letters *ew* .

Listen to each word by clicking on the speaker icon. Sometimes the long /u/ sounds more like a long /oo/ like in the word *boot* .

dew	There is <b>dew</b> on the grass in the morning.
few	Those flowers will die in a <b>few</b> days.
new	The <b>new</b> road will have four wide lanes.
knew	I wish I <b>knew</b> where I left my keys.
pew	A <b>pew</b> is a bench in a church.
stew	The campers ate beef and mushroom <b>stew</b> .
view	There is a <b>view</b> of the sea from my balcony.
interview	June has an <b>interview</b> for a new job.
nephew	My young <b>nephew</b> is called Luke.
curfew	The army put an overnight <b>curfew</b> in place.
mildew	There was black <b>mildew</b> on the damp wall.
review	The critic gave the show a good <b>review</b> .
