## Spelling list: ew words

The long /u/ sound in spelling is pronounced yoo and can be found in words like cube or music .

One way of spelling the long /u/ sound is using the *ew* spelling pattern. This pattern can be found in words like *new*, *few*, and *dew*. The *ew* letter combination is usually placed at the end of a word or syllable.

When spelling words with the *ew* pattern, watch out for words with similar sounds which may have different patterns like *ue* or *u-e*. For example, though they both sound the same, the word *dew* has the *ew* pattern and the word *due* has the *ue* pattern.

Test yourself on these ew spelling pattern using the activities and games that come with this list.
