

## Spelling list: *-ture* words - set 2

In these words the final syllable has a weak sound, a bit like /cher/. This sound is usually spelled *ture* . These words have 3 or 4 syllables:

adventure	Our trip ended up being quite the <b>adventure</b> .
departure	The plane's <b>departure</b> was delayed due to fog.
furniture	All the <b>furniture</b> was damaged in the flood.
miniature	She collected <b>miniature</b> trains.
signature	The document is not valid without a <b>signature</b> .
agriculture	The area was dependent on its <b>agriculture</b> .
horticulture	The outdoor exhibition displayed developments in <b>horticulture</b> over the last hundred years.
literature	The novel was considered a great work of <b>literature</b> .
manufacture	The factory was famous for its <b>manufacture</b> of cars.
temperature	There was a light breeze and the <b>temperature</b> was pleasant.
