

## Spelling list: *-ine* with a long /e/ sound

In these words the final syllable is stressed and has a clear long /e/ sound. On the end of a word this sound is often spelled *i>ine*.

magazine	James wrote an article for the college <b>magazine</b> .
chlorine	We could smell the <b>chlorine</b> as soon as we arrived at the pool.
gasoline	There is a <b>gasoline</b> filling station one mile away.
guillotine	I use a <b>guillotine</b> to cut my leaflets.
machine	The <b>machine</b> operator is an expert at his work.
margarine	Some people prefer <b>margarine</b> to butter.
marine	She wanted to be a <b>marine</b> biologist.
submarine	The warship fired on the enemy <b>submarine</b> .
nicotine	<b>Nicotine</b> is extremely addictive.
quarantine	The patients were kept in <b>quarantine</b> .
ravine	The <b>ravine</b> was deep.
routine	After many years, she became bored of her daily <b>routine</b> .
sardine	The cat ate the <b>sardine</b> .
tambourine	I can play the <b>tambourine</b> .
tangerine	Would you like an apple or a <b>tangerine</b> ?
trampoline	The girl was bouncing higher and higher on the <b>trampoline</b> .
vaccine	The doctor injected the child with a <b>vaccine</b> .
