Words to help you when talking and writing about poems

poetry	Genre is the different kinds of writing for a particular purpose; for example, thriller, romance, novel, <b>poetry</b> .
writer	She is a skillful <b>writer</b> .
rhyme	Time, crime and chime all <b>rhyme</b> .
rhythm	James plays <b>rhythm</b> guitar.
structure	A poem has a <b>structure</b> .
imagery	<b>Imagery</b> is when words are used to create a picture in a reader's mind.
tone	<b>Tone</b> is the feel of the text, indicated by choice of words, rhythm of sentence and such like.
stanza	A poem has a minimum of one <b>stanza</b> .
comparison	We need to make a <b>comparison</b> between these two poems.
compare	Let's <b>compare</b> scores.
vocabulary	Use a thesaurus to widen your <b>vocabulary</b> .
poem	I learnt the <b>poem</b> by rote.
simile	<b>Simile</b> involves describing something by comparing it with something else.
metaphor	A <b>metaphor</b> talks of something as if it is something else.
alliteration	<b>Alliteration</b> involves words that begin with the same sound.
