

Spelling list: *wor* words

The letters *wor* often make the /er/ sound after *w* . This pattern appears in many common words. For example, a *worm* is a small, wriggling creature, and the *world* is the planet we live on. Some *wor* words describe value, like *worth* and *worthless* , while others compare things, such as *worse* and *worst* . Learning this spelling pattern can help with both reading and spelling.

world	Computer technology is changing the world .
worse	The weather made the journey worse .
worst	It was the worst day of his life.
worth	The watch is worth a lot of money.

worthless	The painting was worthless .
