anthropologist	An <b>anthropologist</b> is a social scientist who specializes in anthropology.
archeologist	An <b>archeologist</b> is an anthropologist who studies prehistoric people and their culture.
architect	An <b>architect</b> is someone who creates plans to be used in making buildings.
astronaut	An <b>astronaut</b> is a person trained to travel in a spacecraft.
biologist	A <b>biologist</b> is a scientist who studies living organisms.
chemist	A <b>chemist</b> is a scientist who specializes in chemistry.
ecologist	An <b>ecologist</b> is a biologist who studies the relation between organisms and their environment.
economist	An <b>economist</b> is an expert in the science of economics.
engineer	An <b>engineer</b> is a person who uses scientific knowledge to solve practical problems.
geographer	A <b>geographer</b> is an expert on geography.
geologist	A <b>geologist</b> is a specialist in geology.
historian	A <b>historian</b> is a person who is an authority on history and who studies it and writes about it.
lecturer	A <b>lecturer</b> is someone who lectures professionally.
librarian	A <b>librarian</b> is a professional person trained in library science and engaged in library services.
linguist	A <b>linguist</b> is a specialist in linguistics.
mathematician	A <b>mathematician</b> is a person skilled in mathematics.

professor	A <b>professor</b> is someone who is a member of the faculty at a college or university.
researcher	A <b>researcher</b> is a scientist who devotes himself to doing research.
scientist	A <b>scientist</b> is a person with advanced knowledge of one or more sciences.
teacher	A <b>teacher</b> is a person whose occupation is teaching.
