anthropologist	An anthropologist is a social scientist who specializes in anthropology.
archeologist	An archeologist is an anthropologist who studies prehistoric people and their culture.
architect	An architect is someone who creates plans to be used in making buildings.
astronaut	An astronaut is a person trained to travel in a spacecraft.
biologist	A biologist is a scientist who studies living organisms.
chemist	A chemist is a scientist who specializes in chemistry.
ecologist	An ecologist is a biologist who studies the relation between organisms and their environment.
economist	An economist is an expert in the science of economics.
engineer	An engineer is a person who uses scientific knowledge to solve practical problems.
geographer	A geographer is an expert on geography.
geologist	A geologist is a specialist in geology.
historian	A historian is a person who is an authority on history and who studies it and writes about it.
lecturer	A lecturer is someone who lectures professionally.
librarian	A librarian is a professional person trained in library science and engaged in library services.
linguist	A linguist is a specialist in linguistics.
mathematician	A mathematician is a person skilled in mathematics.

professor	A professor is someone who is a member of the faculty at a college or university.
researcher	A researcher is a scientist who devotes himself to doing research.
scientist	A scientist is a person with advanced knowledge of one or more sciences.
teacher	A teacher is a person whose occupation is teaching.
