

Spelling list: Year 1, Term 1, Week 10: split digraphs *u-e*, *e-e*, and *a-e*

Continuing the theme of split digraphs, this week introduces *u-e*, *e-e*, and *a-e*. Words like *tune* and *made* help students understand how final *e* changes vowel pronunciation from short to long.

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| clown | The clown was so funny! |
| has | The school has three classes. |
| made | Bread is made from wheat. |
| slept | Have you ever slept in a tent? |
| these | Some of these words are hard to spell. |
| tune | Play me a tune on your flute. |
