

## Spelling list: Year 1, Term 3, Week 1: Alternative spelling for *or* , *aw* , *au* , *ore*

This week, we're learning how the *or* sound can be written in different ways. It might appear as *or* as in *for* , *aw* as in *saw* , *au* in *August* , or *ore* in *shore* . These spelling patterns are common in everyday words.

August	It was especially hot this <b>August</b> .
children	The <b>children</b> sat in rows.
crawl	Some insects fly and some <b>crawl</b> .
for	This gift is <b>for</b> you.
next	You are <b>next</b> in line.
or	Do you want juice <b>or</b> milk?
saw	I <b>saw</b> a bird in the tree.
score	I want to increase my spelling <b>score</b> .
shore	We walked by the <b>shore</b> .
short	This book is <b>short</b> and easy to read.
we	<b>We</b> are going to the zoo.
wore	She <b>wore</b> boots in the rain.
