

## Spelling list: Year 1, Term 3, Week 3: /v/ sound at the end of words, /tch/ sound

This week we re focusing on the /v/ sound at the end of words like *have* and *give* , and the /tch/ sound in words like *catch* and *hutch* . Let's learn how to spell and use these words in sentences.

catch	I can <b>catch</b> the ball.
don't	I don't like peas.
fetch	The dog ran to <b>fetch</b> the ball.
give	Please <b>give</b> me a pencil.
have	I <b>have</b> a red balloon.
hutch	Our pet rabbit lives in a <b>hutch</b> .
kitchen	We eat lunch in the <b>kitchen</b> .
live	They <b>live</b> in a beautiful cottage.
old	I like my <b>old</b> jeans more than my new ones.
stitch	I need to <b>stitch</b> up my torn coat.
