This week we are looking at words that take -es when we make them plural. These words often end in *ch* , *sh* , *s* , *x* , or *z* .

bunches	We picked bunches of flowers.
buzzes	The bee buzzes near the flower.
catches	She catches the bus to school.
fusses	The baby fusses when she s tired.
stitches	We mended the torn shirt with stitches .
time	It is time for lunch.
washes	She washes her hands before cooking.
watches	He watches birds in the tree.
