barber	A <b>barber</b> is a hairdresser who cuts hair and shaves beards as a trade.
blacksmith	A <b>blacksmith</b> works with metals in a forge.
bodyguard	A <b>bodyguard</b> is someone who escorts and protects a prominent person.
carpenter	A <b>carpenter</b> is a woodworker who makes or repairs wooden objects.
coach	A <b>coach</b> is someone in charge of training an athlete or a team.
electrician	An <b>electrician</b> is a person who installs or repairs electrical or telephone lines.
farmer	A <b>farmer</b> is someone who operates a farm.
firefighter	A <b>firefighter</b> is a member of a fire department who tries to extinguish fires.
fisherman	A <b>fisherman</b> is someone whose occupation is catching fish.
guard	A <b>guard</b> is a person who keeps watch over something or someone.
guide	A <b>guide</b> is someone who shows the way by leading or advising.
hairdresser	A <b>hairdresser</b> is someone who cuts or beautifies hair.
janitor	A <b>janitor</b> is someone employed to clean and maintain a building.
masseuse	A <b>masseuse</b> is a female massager.
mechanic	A <b>mechanic</b> is someone whose occupation is repairing and maintaining automobiles.
notary	A <b>notary</b> is someone legally empowered to witness signatures and certify a document's validity and to take depositions.
	A <b>plumber</b> is a craftsman who installs and repairs pipes and fixtures and
