

Spelling list: Year 2, Term 1, Week 3: long /e/ spelt ey

The spelling pattern ey makes the long /e/ sound in words like *key* and *trolley* . This spelling often appears at the end of words. Understanding this rule will help learners read and spell a wide variety of nouns and verbs.

alley	An alley runs between the houses.
because	I wore a scarf because it was cold.
chimney	Plumes of smoke emerged from the chimney .
door	There was a knock on the door .
honey	Bees make honey .
key	I have lost my door key again.
money	How much money do you need?
monkey	The monkey ate a banana.
trolley	My sister pushed the trolley in the supermarket.
valley	Shout across the valley to hear the echo.
