| dried    | A <b>dried</b> plum is called a prune.                           |
| drying   | The clothes are <b>drying</b> on the radiator.                   |
| hold     | Mortar is used to <b>hold</b> bricks together.                   |
| kind     | Their new neighbour was very <b>kind</b> .                       |
| replied  | Have you <b>replied</b> to the letter?                           |
| replying | I am <b>replying</b> to a letter.                                |
