

Spelling list: Year 2, Term 2, Week 2: *ie* spelt *y* and *-ies* endings

Students practise the *ie* sound written as *y* at the end of words, and plurals formed with *-ies* . These common patterns help distinguish between singular and plural forms of words.

fries	Mum fries the chips in a large pan.
fry	Shall we fry an egg for breakfast?
parties	I have been invited to two parties this weekend.
pretty	The sunset has pretty colours.
spies	The spies were on a secret mission.
spy	James Bond is a spy in many films.
steak	They serve the best steak in town.
tries	She tries her best on the spelling test.
try	I will try my best.
why	Why are you crying?
