

Spelling list: Year 2, Term 2, Week 7: *-ed* , *-er* , *-est* , *-ing* and *-y*

Learners practise spelling base words modified by common suffixes. These include *-ed* for past tense, *-ing* for present continuous, and *-er* / *-est* for comparisons.

chilliest	Winter is the chilliest time of year.
eye	I have something in my eye .
frying	They cooked breakfast in a frying pan.
funnier	The second comedian in the show was a lot funnier than the first.
happier	I felt happier after I had seen my friend.
happiest	It was the happiest day of my life.
hour	The winning cyclist had an average speed of 34 miles an hour .
luckiest	I felt like the luckiest person in the whole world!
skiing	The skiing expedition was an adventure.
spied	He spied his friend hiding behind the bush.
