This week's list introduces contrasting suffixes: *-ful* to indicate presence and *-less* to show absence. Learning these words will help students build their vocabulary and write with greater precision.

| fearless | She is even fearless around spiders |
| forgetful | Our teacher is sometimes forgetful . |
| hopeless | I am hopeless at doing handstands. |
| joyful | I love parties because they make me joyful . |
| painless | I fell over but it was painless . |
| playful | The puppy was very playful . |
| plentiful | Orange trees are plentiful in sunny Spain. |
| useless | This bike is useless because it has no tyres. |
| whole | He read the whole book in one day. |
