

## Spelling list: Year 3, Term 1, Week 5: long /a/ sound spelt *ei* , *eigh* or *ey*

This list teaches alternate spellings of the long /a/ sound, focusing on words with *ei* , *eigh* , and *ey* .  
Recognising these patterns will help improve reading and spelling accuracy.

beige	The golfer wore <b>beige</b> trousers.
eight	Half of sixteen is <b>eight</b> .
eighth	I was <b>eighth</b> in the line.
grey	The <b>grey</b> clouds looked ominous in the sky.
height	It is easy to adjust the <b>height</b> of the chair.
neighbour	Their new <b>neighbour</b> was very kind.
reign	The queen's <b>reign</b> lasted many years.
sleigh	The <b>sleigh</b> was pulled by reindeer.
they	<b>They</b> wore hoods when it rained
weight	Use a hoist to lift a heavy <b>weight</b> .
