

## Spelling list: Year 3, Term 1, Week 7: *un-* prefix

Students learn how the *un-* prefix changes the meaning of words to their opposites. This pattern is useful for expanding vocabulary.

early	I'm not late, I'm <b>early</b> .
earth	The gardener dug into the <b>earth</b> .
unable	I was <b>unable</b> to spell the word.
unclean	Do not drink the <b>unclean</b> water.
unfasten	The boy found it difficult to <b>unfasten</b> his button.
unhappy	I was <b>unhappy</b> when the snow melted.
unlucky	We were <b>unlucky</b> to lose the game by one goal.
untruthful	He was being <b>untruthful</b> .
unwanted	We gave the <b>unwanted</b> toys to the charity shop.
unwell	I knew I was <b>unwell</b> when I started to feel feverish.
