The prefix *dis-* often adds a negative meaning to root words. This week's list builds awareness of how prefixes change the meaning of words.

disagree	I often disagree with my brother!
disappear	The cars disappear around the corner.
disappoint	I will try not to disappoint you.
disbelieve	She seems to disbelieve what I am saying.
discomfort	The toothache caused her some discomfort at the start.
dishonest	Not being truthful is being dishonest .
dislike	He made no secret of his dislike for custard.
disobey	If I disobey my parents, they will not be pleased.
group	A paragraph is a sentence or group of sentences based around one idea.
guard	The security guard patrolled the building all night.
