

Spelling list: Year 3, Term 1, Week 9: *mis-* prefix

This list introduces the *mis-* prefix, which typically means *wrongly* or *badly* . Students practise words like *mislead* and *misplace* to learn the rule.

Mr	Mr is short for Mister.
heart	A vein carries blood to the heart .
history	We have formed a history society to study our town's past.
learn	With age, we learn to be more and more independent.
misbehave	Do not misbehave in class.
misfortune	Don't laugh at my misfortune .
mislead	The statement was not intended to mislead .
misplace	Did you misplace your homework?
misspell	Many words are easy to misspell .
misunderstand	Did you misunderstand the question?
