

Spelling list: Year 3, Term 2, Week 3: *anti-* and *sub-* prefixes

Students will learn *anti-* (meaning *against*) and *sub-* (meaning *under*). These prefixes are common in everyday vocabulary.

anticlockwise	The opposite to clockwise is anticlockwise .
antifreeze	Use antifreeze to protect the car's engine.
antiseptic	Mum put some antiseptic on his cut knee.
antisocial	Behaving rudely in public is antisocial .
continue	We will continue the meeting after coffee.
subdivide	They will subdivide the building into classrooms.
subheading	A subheading will come under the main heading.
submarine	The warship fired on the enemy submarine .
subtitle	The subtitle explains what the essay is about.
surprise	She raised her eyebrows in surprise .
