

Spelling list: Year 3, Term 2, Week 7: -ly suffix (-le changed to -ly)

This rule shows how adjectives ending in -le change to adverbs by replacing -le with -ly . These words describe how something is done.

gently	The wind blew gently over the beach.
horribly	The skier landed horribly and broke her ankle.
humbly	The performer bowed humbly .
possibly	Pigs cannot possibly fly!
probably	I will probably get full marks in my spelling test.
responsibly	She always acts responsibly .
sensibly	You must learn to behave sensibly .
simply	I simply don't like sprouts, and that's that!
terribly	We got terribly wet in the storm.
woman	The woman sailed around the world.
