The prefix *in-* means *not* and is used to reverse the meaning of a base word. For example, *inactive* means *not active* . Try saying the base word and then add the prefix!

breathe	Inhale means to breathe in.
imagine	I can only imagine how difficult this is for you.
important	It is important to maintain a nutritious diet.
inaccurate	Her maths homework was inaccurate .
inactive	The computer was left inactive .
inaudible	Before Dean could answer, there was an almost inaudible knock at the door.
