

## Spelling list: Year 3, Term 3, Week 4: *ir-* prefix

In this week's list, you'll practise words that begin with *ir-* . This prefix reverses the meaning of the base word it is attached to. For example, *irresponsible* means *not responsible* .

irrational	His decision was <b>irrational</b> .
irregular	<b>Irregular</b> shapes have sides of unequal length.
irrelevant	The judge said that the evidence was <b>irrelevant</b> .
irresistible	The cake was <b>irresistible</b> .
irresponsible	It is <b>irresponsible</b> to drive so fast in a town.
length	The <b>length</b> of the trip made us tired.
material	Denim is the <b>material</b> used to make jeans.
minute	There are sixty seconds in a <b>minute</b> .
natural	Fabric can be made from <b>natural</b> or man-made fibers.
often	I practise my spelling <b>often</b> .
