This list shows how to spell longer words that end in *-sion* or *-tion* . These words are often used in writing to name actions or ideas.

attention	Please give this task your immediate <b>attention</b> .
caught	I have <b>caught</b> three colds so far this year.
confusion	<b>Confusion</b> can lead to misunderstanding.
decision	The <b>decision</b> was unanimous.
explosion	A nova is star that increases brightness due to a sudden <b>explosion</b> .
naughty	The dog was <b>naughty</b> but very cute
possessions	Keep your <b>possessions</b> safe.
question	He was reluctant to answer my <b>question</b> .
television	I have a new television
tension	She finished her sentence with an ellipsis to create <b>tension</b> .
