jealous	He was jealous of his brother's new bike.
mountainous	A large part of Austria is mountainous .
notice	To perceive something is to notice it.
poisonous	The snake's venom was poisonous .
special	A birthday is a special day.
tremendous	The thunder made a tremendous noise.
woman	We need to appoint a new woman for this job.
