courageous	Someone who is courageous shows courage.
courteous	I hope you will behave in a courteous manner
curious	I was curious to see how many people turned up.
hideous	The weather was hideous during the storm.
obvious	It was obvious that the children enjoyed the school trip.
outrageous	His behavior was outrageous .
previous	I've met her on two previous occasions.
serious	We had a serious discussion about what to do.
spontaneous	There was spontaneous applause when he spoke.
various	They filmed at various sites.
