

## Spelling list: Year 4, Term 2, Week 8: *k* spelt *ch*

These are words where the /k/ sound is written as *ch* . This pattern often appears in words borrowed from other languages.

ache	I had a stomach <b>ache</b> .
anchor	The ship dropped <b>anchor</b> in the bay.
chaos	The argument caused <b>chaos</b> .
character	Who is your favourite <b>character</b> in the story?
chemist	The local <b>chemist</b> will have the right medicine for you.
chorus	I've been chosen to sing in the <b>chorus</b> .
echo	Shout across the valley to hear the <b>echo</b> .
mechanic	The <b>mechanic</b> is checking my car.
scheme	A rhyme <b>scheme</b> is the rhyming pattern used in a poem.
stomach	I had a <b>stomach</b> ache.
