bought I **bought** myself some lunch.

brought The baby has **brought** them great joy.

cough She had a terrible **cough** .

dough We need to knead the **dough** to make bread.

enough A dozen eggs will be **enough** .

rough The path was **rough** and rocky.

though Even **though** it's winter the weather is not cold.

thought He **thought** about the interview with apprehension.

through He kicked the ball **through** the window.
