

## Spelling list: Year 6, Term 1, Week 7: Suffixes (vowel letters)

These suffixes begin with vowel letters and are used to change the meaning of word. Notice how the spelling of the root word changes when the suffix is added.

preference	He has a <b>preference</b> for classical music.
preferential	Bingo the dog got <b>preferential</b> treatment to the cat, because he was so cute.
referee	The <b>referee</b> blew his whistle at the end of the game.
reference	If you are stuck, use the instruction book for <b>reference</b> .
referral	He needed a <b>referral</b> for his new job.
referred	The matter was <b>referred</b> to the head teacher.
rhyme	Does the poem <b>rhyme</b> ?
soldier	The poem is about a <b>soldier</b> in the war.
sufficient	Do you have <b>sufficient</b> money for a bus ride home?
transferred	The footballer was <b>transferred</b> to another team.
