This list explores common prefixes that reverse meaning of a root word or indicate that something is not true or not possible.

desperate	I'm <b>desperate</b> for something to eat.
illegal	Many elephants have been killed by <b>illegal</b> ivory traders.
illiterate	An <b>illiterate</b> person cannot read or write.
immature	He was <b>immature</b> for his age.
imperfect	In Latin, I found it hard to learn the <b>imperfect</b> tense.
impossible	It's <b>impossible</b> to hear you.
recycled	<b>Recycled</b> tyres make good flip flops.
replaced	I accidentally broke a mug so I <b>replaced</b> it.
repositioned	We <b>repositioned</b> our tables so we could see the board better.
returned	I <b>returned</b> my library books.
