confidential	The meeting was <b>confidential</b> .
crucial	It is <b>crucial</b> to learn your spellings.
essential	It is <b>essential</b> to eat and drink.
facial	Her <b>facial</b> expression was very funny.
influential	Her speech was very <b>influential</b> .
occupy	I like to <b>occupy</b> my time by trying new recipes.
potentially	If we don't tighten the lid, the liquid could <b>potentially</b> leak.
superficial	<b>Superficial</b> means just on the surface, not underneath.
