

Spelling list: Year 6, Term 3, Week 7: *que* and *sc* words

This week's list looks at words containing *que* and *sc* , which often come from French or Latin roots. Recognising these patterns will help your spelling and pronunciation.

antique	That mahogany cupboard is an antique .
disciplined	We showed disciplined behaviour by listening closely and handling the equipment safely.
fascinated	Our baby is fascinated by that toy.
grotesque	The mould growing on the bread had a grotesque green and black pattern.
individual	Each individual should bring their own food and drink.
mosque	The mosque has a dome on the roof.
science	He was active in the field of science .
scientific	We used a scientific method to test which material was the best insulator.
scenic	We drove home by the scenic route.
unique	The tower was a unique construction.
