Focus on spelling words ending in *tious* and *cious* . These often describe qualities or feelings. Understanding their use will strengthen your vocabulary.

ambitious	The girl was <b>ambitious</b> and tried hard at everything.
cautiously	We <b>cautiously</b> handled the hot equipment using tongs.
consciously	They <b>consciously</b> chose to include everyone in the game.
delicious	Misha ate a <b>delicious</b> chocolate pudding.
fictitious	The characters in this film are purely <b>fictitious</b> .
infections	Washing your hands regularly helps prevent the spread of <b>infections</b> .
nutritious	It is important to maintain a <b>nutritious</b> diet.
plagued	The wasps <b>plagued</b> the garden.
precious	An emerald is a <b>precious</b> stone.
vegetable	I helped my grandmother with her <b>vegetable</b> patch.
