amoeba	An amoeba is a unicellular organism.
cell	A cell is the basic structural and functional unit of all organisms.
nucleus	Nucleus is a scientific term used for the central part of the cell.
coral	A coral is a marine colonial polyp characterized by a calcareous skeleton.
polyp	A polyp is usually sedentary with a hollow cylindrical body and a ring of tentacles around the mouth.
earthworm	An earthworm is a terrestrial worm that burrows into and helps aerate soil.
jellyfish	A jellyfish is a free-swimming coelenterate with stinging tentacles.
leech	A leech is a bloodsucking creature that looks like a worm.
metazoan	A metazoan is an animal of the subkingdom Metazoa.
protoplasm	Protoplasm is the substance of a living cell.
protozoan	A protozoan is a single-celled microscopic animal.
pseudopod	A pseudopod is a temporary outgrowth used by some microorganisms as an organ of feeding or locomotion.
sponge	A sponge is a porous mass of interlacing fibers that forms the internal skeleton of various marine animals.
sucker	A sucker is an organ specialized for sucking nourishment or for adhering to objects by suction.
umbrella	An umbrella the disc of a jellyfish used to move through water.
worm	A worm is relatively small elongated animal that burrows through earth.
